A huge thank you to all who attended the talks and the amazingly positive feedback we received. You know it just encourages us to keep going don't you?



It was the work of Alan Ereira and a television film crew from the BBC that first drew my attention to the higher aspects of Ancient Wisdom.

I sat transfixed as I watched this film in the early 1990s. The film and the book "The Heart of The World" showed the Kogi and their home, the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta, the highest coastal mountain in the world in Columbia.

The Kogi call themselves the Elder Brother and had until then hidden themselves away from the rest of the world in their high mountain home,

The film crew were ushered across a rope bridge to the Kogi village, the only access. It was made very clear that there would only be this one meeting and that they had a

message for us, the younger brother.

This is the message: For the first time the snow had not fallen on the tops of the mountains, that the planet was beginning to warm and our actions were destroying the Earth Mother.

They could ignore younger brother no longer. He was beginning to undermine the very structure of life and the stability of the world. The Elder Brother could no longer look after the world alone. Younger brother is doing too much damage, he must see, understand and take responsibility. Now we have to work together otherwise the world will die.
